Dear Friends,

It is appropriate perhaps in the midst of a season sometimes referred to as 'The Fall' to be reminded that our call is to 'arise shine, for your light has come'. Isaiah's words are expressed out of a heart full of faith and anticipation that God is about to do something. Darkness covers the earth, but the light of God's presence and activity increases until the darkness is no more. Here at the Fountain we have carried this enduring expectation since our foundation rooted in Isaiah 43

'See I am doing a new thing, do you not perceive it?'

It's been expressed in persistent prayer, sacrificial financial giving, extraordinarily high levels of volunteer time (currently 75 hours per week on Kidz Klub alone), a hunger and thirst for entering into Kingdom opportunities such as CAP and WTC and much more.



We may see all too clearly the darkness covering the earth but worldwide, even in the UK, we also see significant holes of light being punched through the veil. It's a time to arise.

At our last Trustees meeting we agreed on two priorities for investment as we move forward: the work of Kidz Klub and strengthening the leadership team by releasing 2 days a week of Paul's time. This will be the focus of our Gift Day this year which is on Sunday 16th November.

The opportunities before Kidz Klub are immense and limited only by hours. Two monthly clubs supported by home visiting; connections with over 20 schools for assemblies or clubs; networking children's workers across East Anglia; pioneering CAP money into schools; and invitations on the table for much more including leading Boulder Gang for about 500 children at New Wine's national summer event in 2016. Extraordinary favour not just to reach a generation with the Gospel but to connect the generations together through the Gospel - a key root to the growth of sustainable revival.

We're building for the long-term not just for today. The opportunities and invitations for Kidz Klub are but a reflection of those set before the church as a whole - the future will be determined by our ability to grasp hold of these in the present. The Kingdom of God is always a 'now' invitation. We believe that to enter into and steward this next season of growth we need to strengthen our leadership team by paying for some of Paul's time enabling him to be employed part-time as assistant minister.

In recent years our Gift Day has been needed to sustain the work - this year our regular budget is on target to be met. Praise God and thank you to each one of you who faithfully and regularly give to the work of the church. This enables us now to invest more intentionally into the future.

Revival is not the preserve of the young - it's for the whole generation alive at any one time. Our purpose is to leave a legacy which sees the government of the King increase as generation succeeds generation. As we pray together, give together, serve together and love together we're part of a movement that is making this possible. Let's see what God will do.


Our Place Family Day
